Welcome and Call to Order: President Dennis Ledford welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes of the November 27, 2012 meeting were approved with no comment.

Recognition of Rhea F. Law, Esq. - Dean Stephen K. Klasko:

 President Genshaft has nominated outgoing Trustee Rhea F. Law for an honorary medical degree, to be conferred at this year's MCOM commencement. Trustee Law has served on the Board of Trustees for many years and has worked diligently on behalf of the medical school and USF Health. President Ledford supports this nomination and offered Faculty Council assistance if needed.

Committee Reports:

Bylaws Committee - Dr. Subhra Mohapatra, Committee Chair:

• The Committee has been asked to restructure the Academic Performance Review Committee. Dr. Steven Specter, Associate Dean for Student Affairs, has been invited to the next meeting to provide additional information. President Ledford has asked the Committee to review the overall committee structure and to consider extending the President's term to two years, after his term has ended.

Curriculum Committee - Dr. Craig Doupnik, Committee Chair:

• Dr. Doupnik and Dr. Mary Lien, Curriculum Committee member and Faculty Council representative, presented the restructured Year 3 Clerkship, which was recently approved and announced to faculty. The restructuring applies to the core curriculum, not Lehigh Valley. Among other changes, a new series of Friday afternoon seminars and small group sessions will be introduced.

Physicians Assistant Subcommittee - Dr. Javier Cuevas, Committee Chair:

• The subcommittee will have its first meeting in February. Dr. Cuevas will report to the Faculty Council following that meeting.

Research Space - Dr. Stephen Liggett, Vice Dean for Research

- Dr. Liggett explained the metrics that were used in the recent effort to reallocate faculty research space based on funding. Some shared PI space will be available for faculty who have lost funding.
- Cores have not yet been reviewed. It was noted that the MCOM Committee on Research (COMCOR) has examined cores in the past. Perhaps COMCOR would be the appropriate group to work with Dr. Liggett on core review. President Ledford will ask for a COMCOR report at an upcoming Faculty Council meeting.
