

Transfer of Antepartum Patient to Another Facility

POLICY

Stabilized antepartum patients may be transferred to a higher level of obstetrical/neonatal care.

PURPOSE

To establish guidelines for transfer of patients from (facility name) to another facility.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Primary care physician should discuss plan/need to transfer patient to another facility with patient and family.
- 2. Physician should order transfer to another facility. The Physician will contact "Transfer Center" at 1-(phone number). The accepting physician will be assigned as the patients physician.
- 3. Notify Care Management or Nursing Supervisor
- 4. Three hospital forms should be completed. Original is to be placed in patient's chart and a copy is given to the transferring agent (ambulance).
 - a. Physician Certification for need to transfer
 - b. Patient Consent
 - c. Physicians Certification Statement for Advanced patient transportation.
- 5. Ambulance service will be arranged by Transfer Center

- 6. RN should call and give verbal report to receiving patient care unit/RN.
- 7. Relevant patient information, i.e. labs, prenatal history, MAR, etc., should be copied for transfer with patient.
- 8. RN should prepare patient for transfer as order by physician.
- 9. If physician requests, an RN may accompany patient during transfer to accepting facility.
- 10. Advanced Patient Transportation / Physician Certificate Statement and Patient consent to transfer can be found at Team Leader station.
