



Patient Data Collection and Submission

Data is an essential component of quality improvement and we will use its insight to guide the Mother-Focused Care (MFC) initiative. Please review and implement the data collection tools described below and note the data submission guidelines.

Data Submission:

- MFC patient-level data collection starts on July 1st, 2023 (it needs to be submitted by August 15th, 2023).
- Submit monthly data by the 15th of the following month until the end of the initiative
- Once your DUA is executed, FPQC will email your MFC data and project lead a link to submit your data. Please bookmark the link and use it throughout the initiative.

Aggregate data:

Submit monthly the total number of:

1. patients discharged home after delivery
2. patients discharged home after delivery with SDOH screening documented using a SDOH screening tool
3. patients discharged home after delivery with a positive SDOH screening
4. patients discharged home after delivery with a positive SDOH screening linked to needed resources/services complete

SDOH sample data:

- Abstract the medical record of the first 10 women admitted for delivery **who screened positive for SDOH** and were discharged home, excluding women with a fetal/infant demise.
- Abstract SDOH data for each selected chart using the MFC Patient Level Data Collection Form
- Assign a "Study ID #" to each case abstracted starting with 001 and continue sequentially until the end of the initiative.
- Please keep a [log](#) of the patients whose data is submitted to FPQC. Include the patient's medical record number, the assigned study ID, and the return code that you will get when submitting the patient's data to FPQC. This will allow for data confirmation and corrections. This log is intended for your hospital use only, please never send it to FPQC.
