A. Personal Statement

The proposed research has been designed to assess the attitudes, subjective norms and perceived behavioral control among oral health providers that may be predictive of intention to perform the HPV related oral cancer prevention behaviors, such as communication with patients. Specifically, we propose an exploratory 2 year theory-based study utilizing mixed methods with the following specific aims: 1) Elicit key attitudes, subjective norms, and perceived behavioral control pertaining to HPV related OC prevention behaviors among OHP; and 2) Determine factors (i.e. attitudes, subjective norms, perceived behavioral norms, knowledge, demographic variables) predictive of intention to engage in the two HPV related OC prevention behaviors. Aim 1 will be achieved via focus groups at national OHP annual meetings; Aim 2 will be achieved via a theory-based cross-sectional study of randomly selected practicing OHP in the US. As is demonstrated in this bio-sketch, I have the experience and capabilities to successfully carry out this research from conceptualization to dissemination. I have directed two large peer-reviewed studies related to HPV, including the Cognitive and Emotional Response to HPV in Men (The CER Study –1RO-1CA123346). I have over 25 years' experience in the creation and administration of reproductive clinics in three states, which brings an element of familiarity with clinical matters both to the current pilot study and to the proposed project. Collaboration with Dr. DeBate (Co-I) will further ensure success as she will add her significant experience with innovative oral health provider research and interventions. I believe that my expertise, experience and previous success make me a successful candidate to conduct this research. Dr. DeBate and I form a dedicated and skilled team capable of accomplishing this study.
