### Application Checklist

**Early Decision Deadline: September 2, 2011**

**Regular Decision Deadline: December 1, 2011**

For an application to be considered complete all applicants are required to submit the following items:

- E-Submit the PharmCAS application ([www.pharmcas.org](http://www.pharmcas.org)). All U.S. college transcripts and PCAT scores must be sent to PharmCAS.
- PCAT test scores. PCAT test scores must be submitted to PharmCAS (use code 104). Scores older than three years will not be accepted.
- Two letters of recommendation must be submitted to PharmCAS. **One letter must be from a science professor.**
- E-submit Supplemental Application. Invited applicants will be provided a link to fill out the online application and have two-weeks in which to complete the application.
- E-submit Supplemental Application non-refundable fee (\$30). This fee is paid either by electronic check or credit card at the time you submit the online supplemental application.
- Residency form (**In-state and out-of-state applicants must submit this form**). Must be mailed to the USF COP Office of Admissions. Ensure that your PharmCAS ID is on the form.
- Two (2) proofs of residency (**submit only if claiming Florida residency**). Must be mailed to the USF COP Office of Admissions. Ensure that your PharmCAS ID is on the proofs.
- Official AP and IB test scores, if applicable. Must be mailed to the USF COP Office of Admissions.
