## **A. Substance Use Inclusion-Exclusion Criteria**

The article must meet the following conditions:

The article includes content related to any aspect of ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, DRUGS, and DRINKING AND DRIVING. (These articles are NOT limited to only those that pertain to youth.)

- These articles may be related to *purchasing* or *obtaining* alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- These articles may be related to *use* of alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- These articles may be related to the *production* or *selling* of alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- These articles may be related to the *health consequences* of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.
- These articles may be related to the *legal consequences* of alcohol, tobacco or drug use.
- These articles may be related to the *developmental consequences* of alcohol, tobacco or drug use.
- These articles may be related to the *social consequences* of alcohol, tobacco or drug use.
- These articles may be related to the *predictors* or *correlates* of alcohol, tobacco or drug use.
- These articles may be related to the announcement or reporting of a fund raiser, as long as the article refers to the amount of money raised OR the groups attending.
  - Do NOT include the article if it is merely reporting the facts related to the logistics of the fundraising event (e.g. time and place that it will occur).
  - DO include the article if it provides specific information on agencies that collaborated at the event, how much money was raised, or the number of people who attended.
- These articles may be related to *announcing* a meeting, forum, etc. of a group formed to address issues related to alcohol, tobacco, or drug use or drinking and driving.
  - Do NOT include the article if it is merely reporting the facts related to the meeting location and time
  - DO include the article if it provides specific information related to actions that will be (or were) taken by the group related to alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or drinking and driving, mentions what organizations/individuals attended the meeting/event, OR mentions community collaboration at the meeting/event.
- These articles may be related to *reporting* on the activities of a group formed to address issues related to alcohol, tobacco, or drug use or drinking and driving.
- These articles may be related to *describing* an intervention that targets alcohol, tobacco, drug use or drinking and driving or the selling or production of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.
- These articles may be a part of an advice column (such as Ann Landers, Dear Abbey, or Dr. Donahue).

AND

The article is NOT one of the following:

- part of a classified ad.
- an advertisement of any kind.
- part of the comic strips located in the cartoon section.
- part of any tables and listings of stock and commodities prices.
- a recipe or school lunch menu.
- part of a movie review.
- part of a funeral or engagement announcement.
- part of an obituary.
- an announcement of an event (providing only date, location, and time)

## **B. Adolescent Health Inclusion-Exclusion Criteria**

The article must meet the following conditions:

The article includes content related to ADOLESCENT or YOUTH or TEENAGER and HEALTH.

- “HEALTH” refers to any aspect of the physical, social, and psychological health of the adolescent.
- “ADOLESCENT/YOUTH/TEENAGER” refers to individuals who are in the middle or high school years. A clear age range is not provided due to variability.
  - Examples of physical health include but are not limited to substance use, nutrition, physical activity, and sexual health.
  - Examples of social health include but are not limited to social growth and development, violence, and delinquency.
  - Examples of psychological health include but are not limited to mental health, self-esteem, stress, and suicide.

AND

The article is NOT one of the following:

- part of a classified ad.
- an advertisement of any kind.
- part of the comic strips located in the cartoon section.
- part of any tables and listings of stock and commodities prices.
- a recipe or school lunch menu.
- part of a movie review.
- part of a funeral or engagement announcement.
- part of an obituary.
- an announcement of an event (providing only date, location, and time)

### **C. Community Capacity Inclusion Criteria**

The article must meet the following conditions:

The article includes content related to any aspect of COMMUNITY CAPACITY, COMMUNITY COALITIONS, COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT, COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION, or COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT. The content must have already occurred and should have a local focus (although state and national articles may be included if they discuss the impact on the local community).

- These articles may be related to changes in political office or reporting on the politics of the local community, as long as the article provides information related to the impact of a political officer or policy on the community.
- These articles may be related to community business, as long as the article reports on the social benefits to the community and NOT merely the financial benefits.
- These articles may be related to factors that contribute to community sustainability:
  - Articles may report on a catalyst or champion for the community
  - Articles may report on fund-raising events, as long as they provide information related to the amount of money made, who attended, or any collaboration that occurred and do NOT merely report the date and location of where it occurred. The articles must explicitly indicate how the money will benefit the community.
  - Articles may report on community group meetings or events as long as they provide details on who collaborated, who attended, or what outcome resulted from the event/meeting and do NOT merely report that the event occurred.
  - Articles may report on community training or education seminars as long as they provide information on the benefits to the community.
  - Articles may report on the use of community services such as library facilities, recreation centers, etc.
  - Articles may report on the cohesiveness or trust among community members.

AND

The article is NOT one of the following:

- part of a classified ad.
- an advertisement of any kind.
- part of the comic strips located in the cartoon section.
- part of any tables and listings of stock and commodities prices.
- a recipe or school lunch menu.
- part of a movie review.
- part of a funeral or engagement announcement.
- part of an obituary.
- an announcement of an event (providing only date, location, and time)
