[Cognitive Deficits in Schizophrenia](#), Principle Investigator Carlos Santana, M.D. – The USF Department of Psychiatry is participating in a nationwide clinical research trial evaluating the safety and efficacy of an investigational medication used in the treatment of [Cognitive Deficits in Schizophrenia](#). This is a 12 week study for males and females between the ages of 20-55. Subjects must have been diagnosed or treated for schizophrenia for at least 2 years prior to screening and be stable on 1-2 atypical antipsychotic medications. [Schizophrenia](#) Jail Study – A 15 month open label study comparing oral antipsychotic treatment to paliperidone palmitate injections in delaying arrest recidivism in adults with [Schizophrenia](#). Subjects must have been incarcerated at least twice in the last 24 months with the last release from jail occurring within 45 days prior to screening.
