THE BCS Distinguished Lectures Series will take place on Monday, May 10, 2010 with "Improving Health and Healthcare for Persons with Serious Mental Illness" by Benjamin Druss, M.D., MPH, Rosalynn Carter Chair in Mental Health, Rollins School of Public Health, Emory University. This will be held at 3:00 – 4:30 p.m. and a reception at 4:30 – 5:00 p.m. in the COPH Sam Bell Auditorium 1023-A. Persons with serious mental disorders are increasingly regarded as a health disparities population, due to poor quality of care and excess rates of medical comorbidity, and premature mortality. This presentation will review the historical roots and causes of this crisis, and describe current research models, community efforts and policy approaches to addressing it.
