Instructions for Admissions Cycle Beginning September 1, 2009 and Ending November 15, 2009

1. Download and print out the instructions for completing the application portfolio and the following five (5) application documents:
 - a. Applicant Data-Residency-Fee Sheet
 - b. Prerequisite Course Completion Plan
 - c. Legal Disclosure Form
 - d. Autobiography and Purpose Statement Form
 - e. Clinical Observation Experience/Professional Abilities Assessment Form
(Multiple copies may be made. Please use a separate form for each clinical observation experience).
2. Fully complete each form by typing in the information as required. Mail completed forms to:

Completed applications received by November 15, 2009, **including required application fee** will be reviewed by the SPTRS Faculty Admissions Committee to select the 36 most qualified applicants for enrollment as a member of the DPT Class of 2013. Letters of Offer will be mailed to selected students on/about February 1, 2010. A Waiting List will be maintained of otherwise qualified applicants in the event that a class opening should occur. Individuals on the Waiting List will have the opportunity to roll over their application portfolio for priority consideration the following year.

Please note: Meeting minimum admissions requirements does not guarantee admission to the School of Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Sciences.
