The Committee conducted regular monthly meetings on the third Wednesday of each month at 7:30 a.m. In addition, the Committee met for a full day in December 2006 to review applications for the 2006-2007 promotion and tenure cycle.

The Committee considered requests for 16 faculty appointments at senior rank and one sabbatical, and made its recommendations to the Dean. During the annual promotion and tenure review process, 39 applications were considered. The Committee met with the Dean in January to present its recommendations with regard to promotion and tenure.

This year, the Committee reviewed the dossiers of four faculty members as part of the annual Progress Toward Promotion and Tenure process. Written feedback was provided.

The Committee was represented by its Chair at the annual Promotion and Tenure Workshop in June.
