The members of the College of Medicine Appointment, Promotion and Tenure (APT) Committee for 2007-2008 were: Wenlong Bai, PhD; Claudia Berman, MD; Richard Heller, PhD; Thomas Klein, PhD; Richard Roetzheim, MD; Aryn Rojiani, MD, PhD; David Sheehan, MD; Laura Lee Swisher, PhD, PT; and David Solomon, MD, who served as Chair. John Curran, MD, Senior Executive Associate Dean for Faculty and Academic Affairs, served as the administrative liaison. The Committee conducted regular monthly meetings on the third Wednesday of each month at 7:30 a.m. In addition, the Committee met for a full day in December 2007 to review applications for the 2007-2008 promotion and tenure cycle.

Throughout the year, the APT Committee considered requests for 23 faculty appointments and one joint appointment at senior rank, and made its recommendations to the Dean.

During the 2007-08 promotion and tenure review process, 37 applications were considered. An electronic application review process was implemented during this cycle and was very successful. In January, the Committee met with Dr. Stephen Klasko, Senior Vice President of USF Health and Dean of Medicine, to present its recommendations with regard to the promotion and tenure candidates.

This year, the Committee reviewed the dossiers of four faculty members as part of the annual Progress Toward Tenure process. Written feedback was provided.

During the year, the Committee had discussions and made recommendations with regard to the College of Medicine Appointment, Promotion and Tenure Guidelines, as well as the Post-Tenure Review process.

The Committee was represented by its Chair at the annual Promotion and Tenure Workshop in June.
