- From I-275: From I-275 traveling North (from Tampa International Airport) or traveling South, take exit 51 for Fowler Ave. Travel East 2 miles towards University of South Florida. The Embassy Suites Tampa Busch Gardens hotel is on the left after the intersection of Fowler and 30th street.
- From I-75: From I-75 traveling North (from Sarasota/Ft.
