The NIH has released new requirements which can be found at <http://grants.nih.gov/grants/guide/notice-files/NOT-OD-10-019.html>

NIH now requires that all trainees, fellows, participants, and scholars receiving support through any NIH training grant, career development award (individual or institutional), research education grant, or dissertation research grant receive 8 hours of instruction in the responsible conduct of research every 4 years.

This policy took effect with all new and renewal applications submitted on or after January 25, 2010, and for all continuation (Type 5) applications with deadlines on or after January 1, 2011.

NIH now requires that all faculty, administration, staff and temporary employees, including students and post docs, receiving support through any NIH training grant, career development award (individual or institutional), research education grant, or dissertation research grant receive 8 hours of instruction in the responsible conduct of research every 4 years. This 2 hour workshop is applied toward this requirement. Certificates of completion will be issued.

This policy took effect with all new and renewal applications submitted on or after January 25, 2010, and for all continuation (Type 5) applications with deadlines on or after January 1, 2011.
