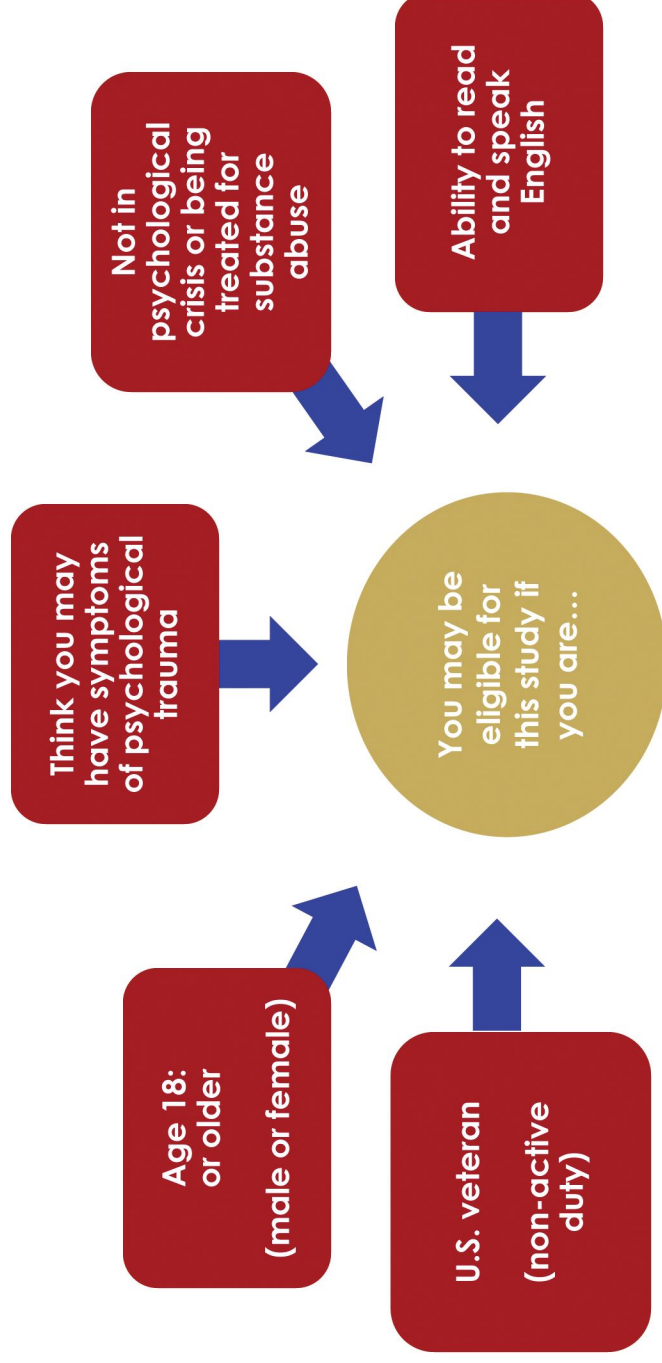




RESEARCH BEING CONDUCTED FOR SYMPTOMS OF PSYCHOLOGICAL TRAUMA
