

# *Types of Employment at the University of South Florida:*

The University of South Florida offers specific positions based on what your department is looking for. Below are the job classifications and web links with detailed information.

## *Faculty*

Faculty positions are defined as positions assigned the principal responsibility of teaching, research, or public service activities or for administrative responsibility for functions directly related to the academic mission. Faculty employees are appointed by academic periods, usually twelve or nine months. Additional terms and conditions of employment may be specified.

## *Administration*
