- Current target (shortfall) is \$762,544
  - Looking at:
    - o operating expenses
    - Staff reduction
    - o Attrition

      - If shortfall is not that much; is there a particular area of the four above that faculty would prefer to take off the list?
      - Please email thoughts to Dr. Petersen
      - If need be we will call another faculty meeting
      - Paula Knaus will investigate 9 month appointments
