 - The chair will look at the red flag areas and focus on what the COPH was weak on last time.
- > The team will look at the hiring process
- The team will look at data that shows if the students are meeting their planned objectives set forth by each student and his/her advisor.
- > The team will review the faculty evaluations.
- The team will hold a meeting and/or attend a luncheon (s) with faculty. The team will also meet with students and COPH alumni.
- Dr. Mahan stated that he feels COPH looks much better now than it did 5 years ago. The self-study is more organized and includes clear data on the status of the COPH.
