- 1. Meeting called to order by Dr. Mason
- 2. November 15 2013 minutes approved.
- 3. New Business
  - a. Communications Natalie Preston-Washington
    - Utilize different strategies to improve communication of COPH activities, accomplishments, teaching and research
    - Monday letter & ASPH Friday letters Faculty encourage to submit stories of interest and are asked to include in their short submissions who, what, where & why
    - Links to Facebook, Linkedin and other social media is encouraged
    - Promotional and branding items can be coordinated
- 4. Reports from Standing Committees
  - a. Curriculum:
    - The USF Graduate Council approved the Change in the requirement for the MSPH program. The comprehensive exam is no longer required for students and in its place students will be required to successfully complete a thesis proposal defense. This only applies to four departments: EPB, CFH, GLO, & HPM. EOH opted to keep the comprehensive exam as a requirement for their programs.
  - b. Faculty Senate:
    - Revised Tenure & Promotion document has been approved including the Provost's Office. Change to the approved document has been made. The next step include translating the new guidelines into policy; includes defining terms and assigning value; e.g., what does the move from strong to excellent mean

- 3 University committees are being re-constituted; change in financial system management to RCM (Responsibility Center Management)
- Travel management company has been selected Orbitz for business. Processes and procedures will be piloted in three offices at COPH
- Explorance Blue
  - Course evaluations will now be conducted in the last week of classes and reminders will be sent to student to encourage participation. Evaluations for courses with multiple instructors will now be included.
  - faculty are encourage to set aside time in the last class to encourage student participation in completing course evaluation
  - evaluation reports are not loaded onto FAIR system
  - Faculty are requested to send a copy of the Explorance Blue report to their respective department chairs and to Marilyn

### c. Research Committee

# 5. Updates/ Comments - Dean's Office

Overall, enrollment has increased significantly throughout the year, driven largely by undergraduate enrollment.

## **Spring 2014:**

- . Undergraduate enrollment has generated 17,977 student contact hours, which translates to almost 450 FTE. This is an increase of almost 51 FTE from the Fall 2013 term, and 47 FTE from Spring 2013.
- . Graduate enrollment is down about 17 FTE when compared to Fall 2013; however, spring enrollment is typically less than fall in general. On the positive side, Spring 2014 enrollment is 17 FTE higher than Spring 13.
- . Self-funded programs continue to grow as well; we have 76 students generating over 450 student contact hours this spring. This is may be the largest number of students in these programs.

Overall we are well above our funding plan at both the Graduate and UG levels.

COPH faculty have taught 60,814 gross student contacts this year, compared to 52,826 last year. The figures may change but are expected to be beyond target enrollment levels.
