Meeting Minutes

1. Minutes from the April 26th meeting were reviewed and approved as written.
2. Results of the Summer 2010 core exam were reviewed.
3. Dr. Sanchez-Anguiano asked for clarification of rule(s) for passing the Core Comp Exam. She reminded the Committee had voted for the following: Students need a score of 50% or better to pass the Biostatistics section of the Core Comp Exam, and a 70% or better to pass each of the remaining sections. It was also reviewed the recommendation on increasing the weight of the exam on Capstone course from 15 to 25%. Members agreed that those were the scores and weight voted and approved.

Action needed:

Clarify with the Academic Dean rules for passing the Core Comp Exam.

Follow-up needed: Follow-up on the recommendation of the Committee (April meeting) that the weight of the Core Comprehensive Exam, given in the Capstone Course, be increased to at least 25% of the student's grade.

4. The Committee discussed the need to study the Special Project Guidelines to determine whether they meet specific and certain criteria.
