NIH: Parenting Capacities, Health Outcomes in Youths, Adolescents – Multiple Due Dates

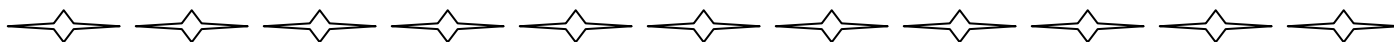
