The University of South Florida is among the nation's top 63 public research universities and one of 39 community engaged public universities as designated by the *Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching*. It is one of Florida's top three research universities and was awarded more than \$300 million in research contracts and grants last year. The University offers 219 degree programs at the undergraduate, graduate, specialist and doctoral levels, including the Doctor of Medicine. The University has a \$1.8 billion annual budget, an annual economic impact of \$3.2 billion, and serves more than 45,000 students on campuses in Tampa, St. Petersburg, Sarasota-Manatee and Lakeland. USF is a member of the Big East Athletic Conference.

USF Health is the USF's enterprise of faculty, staff, and students dedicated to improving the full continuum of health. USF Health has at its core the colleges of Medicine, Nursing, and Public Health. Also included are the schools of Biomedical Sciences and Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Sciences. Its clinicians deliver healthcare at USF Health South Tampa Center and the Carol & Frank Morsani Ambulatory Care Center as well as at its affiliated hospitals which include the Tampa General Hospital, H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center & Research Institute, James A. Haley Veterans Medical Center, Shriners Hospital for Children, and All Children's Hospital.
