- a. North Courtyard: Design package completed, funding allocated for construction package this FY, to include shade sails, wifi power, performing test patch near Auditorium & 1096/1097, construction work will be completed at night
- b. USF Health Campus Way Finding Signage: Programming phase in progress, some project work will tie in with SSS renovations which will include electronic enhancements, will use College of Nursing as model, new signage installed
- c. USF Health Heart Institute: Project programming phase completed, 100,000 sq ft 5 story facility, estimated Target Ground Breaking is March 2015, Designer/Architect has been selected (Whiting Turner/HOK) and design effort has started
- d. Library Improvement: Plans for re-roofing entire Library Facility, construction work completed, courtyard improvements and more quiet study space planned for the 2nd Floor, Targeted finish date in mid-October
- e. COPH Lecture Hall Renovation: Construction is 80% completed, target completion date of late October.
- f. Student Union Project (CITF Funds/SSS: Phase II to include Student Union/CITF- food service, wellness, gym, renovation process for old clinic spaces has been proposed as program to accommodate wellness center and food court has started, construction targeted to start in January 2015, no food vendors has been selected yet
- g. MDL 1003/1005: Design package has been completed, funding has been approved, construction to start in Spring 2015
- h. Pharmacy Plus: Construction is completed
- i. ALZ Vivarium Shell Area Buildout: Dr. Engleman is funding to buildout basement for more space, however, project now on hold due to funding, design package completed
- j. MDT East Wing Expansion: Design underway to expand courtyard to add offices and labs, in programming phase
