Established Patient Review of Systems

Please circle one if you have any of the below symptoms:

Constitutional – <i>appetite loss, chills, diaphoresis (excessive sweating), fever, generalized weakness, malaise/fatigue, night sweats, weight gain, weight loss</i>
Eyes – <i>blurred vision, discharge, double vision, pain, photophobia (sensitivity to light), redness, loss of vision (left or right), visual disturbance, visual halos</i>
Respiratory – <i>cough, hemoptysis (blood in sputum), shortness of breath, sleep disturbance due to breathing, snoring, sputum production, wheezing</i>
Skin – <i>changes in nail beds, discoloration, dryness, flushing, itching, poor wound healing, rashes, skin cancer, suspicious lesions, unusual hair distribution</i>
HENT – <i>congestion, ear discharge, ear pain, hearing loss, hoarseness, nosebleeds,odynophagia (pain when swallowing), sore throat, stridor (high pitched breathing sound), tinnitus (ringing in ears)</i>
Cardiovascular – <i>chest pain, claudication (cramping pain of the legs induced by walking) cyanosis, dyspnea (shortness of breath) on exertion, irregular heartbeat, swelling of feet and legs, near-syncope (fainting), orthopnea (trouble breathing when lying flat), palpitations, PND, syncope (fainting)</i>
Endocrine – <i>intolerant to heat, intolerance to cold, polydipsia (excessive thirst), polyphagia (excessive hunger), polyuria (excessive urination)</i>
Hematologic – <i>adenopathy (enlarged lymph nodes), bleeding, easy bruising or bleeding</i>
Musculoskeletal – <i>arthritis, back pain, falls, gout, joint pain, joint swelling, muscle cramps, muscle weakness, myalgias (muscle aches), neck pain, stiffness</i>
Gastrointestinal – <i>abdominal bloating, abdominal pain, anorexia, bowel habits changed, bowel incontinence, constipation, diarrhea, dysphagia (difficulty swallowing), excessive appetite, flatus, heartburn, hematemesis (blood in vomitus), hematochezia (passage of blood per the rectum), hemorrhoids, jaundice, melena (black tarry stools), nausea, vomiting</i>
Genitourinary – <i>bladder incontinence, decreased libido (sex drive), dysuria (painful urination), flank pain, frequency, genital sore, hematuria (blood in urine) hesitancy, incomplete emptying, menorrhagia (painful menstruation) missed menses, nocturia (urinating frequently at night), non-menstrual bleeding, pelvic pain, urgency</i>
Neurological – <i>aphonia (loss of ability to speak), brief paralysis, concentration difficulties, daytime sleepiness, dizziness, focal weakness, headaches, light-headedness, loss of balance, numbness paresthesia (tingling), seizures, sensory changes, tremors, vertigo, difficulty walking</i>
Psychiatric – <i>altered mental status (confusion), depression, hallucinations, hypervigilance (enhanced sensory sensitivity) insomnia, memory loss, nervous/anxious, substance abuse, suicidal ideas, thoughts of violence</i>
Allergy/ Immunological – <i>environmental allergies, HIV exposure, persistent infections, Hepatitis A B C</i>
