The primary goal of the youth and young adult HIV program is to improve the health and lives of infected youth through excellent medical care, access to clinical trials, psychosocial support and education. The department provides a "medical home" with 24 hour on call services and medical case management services. The clinic serves patients aged 12-21 with chronic health care issues, including HIV infection. Through the generous donations of community members and foundation support several HIV positive youth attend summer camping sessions each year, and participate in other recreational activities.
