Report for Faculty Council Academic Performance Review Committee Academic Year 2007-2008

The Academic Performance Review Committee (APRC) met 12 times during academic year 2007-08 in regularly scheduled or special meetings. During that period there were 70 students reviewed by the committee. The APRC dismissed 2 students during the academic year. One student appealed this decision, and the other did not. One decision to dismiss was reversed by Dr. Klasko following the recommendation of his designated appeals committee. There was one additional appeal of a committee decision to require a one-month remediation of a clerkship. This decision was upheld by the APRC.

Actions of the committee included review of and recommendation of actions for failing academic performance, overall weak academic performance, USMLE exam failure, and disciplinary actions related to issues of unprofessional behavior. 42 students were placed on academic probation during the course of the year.

In addition, the APRC recommended to Dean Klasko, all students in good standing for promotion to years 2, 3 and 4 and 115 members of the Class of 2008 for graduation.
