1. | Welcome, Review and Approve Minutes | **Presenter:** Eric Bennett

2. | Financial / Budget Update | **Presenter:** Joann Strobbe

- P4P Model for Basic Science faculty members goes into effect July 1, 2016. Has been discussed with the chairs; a low number of people (<10) will be affected by the salary reduction, and the gaps appear to be small. Dr. Lockwood is looking at the possibility of changing the %ages for next year.
- Budget Reviews have begun – looking at Q1&2 status as well as FY 17 projections. Clinical Departments are not being asked to provide projections.
- Legislative Update – staff salary increases are still being debated; PECO Funding – we’ve requested 22.5 million for downtown project.

3. | MCOM Bonus Overview

- Bonuses Paid out January 2016 - \$258,000 for Research + \$256,00 for Education
- Research Bonuses determined by formula based on NIH Funding + salary savings; the breakdown is listed on the Faculty Council Website. 29 researchers earned bonuses which ranged from \$1,500 - \$31,000.
- Dr. Liggett will continue to work on the wording and allocation of Research Bonuses for next year.
- Education Bonuses were determined by Quality Metrics w/ a minimum requirement of .3 EVUs or higher to be eligible. Approximately 100 out of 365 faculty met that requirement and 70 of those received bonuses.
- Discussed need for some flexibility allowing for qualitative allocating of bonuses by the chairs; Need alignment between the Chair incentives and the faculty incentives. Suggestion to consider lowering the .3 EVU requirement.
- Information regarding the Faculty Bonuses needs to be posted on the Faculty Council Website.
