

Pre-Implementation Phase Key Practices

- Assure early multidisciplinary support by educating and identifying key champions in all pertinent departments.
- 2. Establish clear regular communication channels and processes, assuring that all necessary departments are represented.
- 3. Establish and test billing codes and processes to assure adequate and timely reimbursement.



Pre-Implementation Phase Key Practices (cont.)

- 4. Expand pharmacy capacity and device distribution to assure timely placement.
- 5. Educate clinicians, community partners and nurses about efficacy of pLARC within the full range of contraception, informed consent and shared decision making.
- 6. Educate clinicians, nurses and lactation consultants about the benefits and clinical recommendations related to pLARC placement and breastfeeding
