Computer Requirements

- DSL/Cable internet connection (we cannot guarantee dial-up connections)
- Have audio capabilities on your computer: sound card with speakers and a microphone, or headset
- Java Webstart Visit the Collaborate First Time User to run the Java software check


Preparing for the Collaborate Sessions:
