<p><b>Create a Research Question</b> (This is the actual statement you will use in Project 2.)</p>	<p>Your research statement meets ANY of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>making a definitive claim rather than a statement about a relationship or outcome</li> <li>not related to public health</li> <li>no research statement provided</li> </ul>	<p>Your research statement meets ANY of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>too broad (it cannot be conducted in the span of this course)</li> <li>too specific (it only answers one question and doesn't consider other questions)</li> <li>missing one or more of the criteria listed in 2 pts column</li> </ul>	<p>Your research statement meets ALL of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>presents a proposed relationship or outcome (Does NOT make a formal research claim.)</li> <li>specific enough to find data to measure it</li> <li>presented as a statement</li> <li>related to public health</li> </ul>
<p><b>Present sources for a Literature Review-</b> (This is a proposed list of sources, and may not include the actual list of sources you will use.)</p>	<p>Your literature review meets ANY of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>mostly newspapers or anecdotal sources</li> <li>does NOT use any of the sources listed in the 2pt column</li> <li>no literature review section provided</li> </ul>	<p>Your literature review meets ANY of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>mostly from trade journals or consumer magazines</li> </ul>	<p>Your literature review meets ALL of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>mostly from journals, books, government/ academic supported websites</li> <li>limited use of anecdotal resources or newspaper clippings</li> </ul>
<p><b>Identify Objectives-</b> (These are the actual objectives you will use in project 2.)</p>	<p>Your objectives meet ANY of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No relationship/not applicable to research question</li> <li>Too general AND not measurable</li> <li>No objectives given</li> </ul>	<p>Your objectives meet ANY of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Too general (so it does not support the research question)</li> <li>Not measurable (must include an outcome that can be measured)</li> <li>Measures cannot be displayed visually (e.g. table, chart, graph, flowchart etc)</li> </ul>	<p>Your objectives meet ALL of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Specific</li> <li>Measurable</li> <li>Incorporates the use of descriptive statistics</li> <li>Measures can displayed visually (e.g. tables, graphs, flowcharts)</li> <li>Applicable to the research question</li> </ul>

<b>Identify Methods-</b> (These are proposed methods you may use, but may not end up being the same ones you use in Project 2.)	Your methods meet ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No discussion how data is gathered</li> <li>No logical tie into the objectives</li> <li>Disjointed presentation</li> </ul>	Your methods meet ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Not enough methods to support each of the objectives</li> <li>Too vague of a description</li> <li>Missing one or more of the criteria listed in 2 pts column</li> </ul>	Your methods meet ALL of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Includes a paragraph (3-4 sentences) how the data will be gathered</li> <li>Includes one paragraph per method (3-4 sentences per paragraph)</li> <li>Each method includes the type of descriptive stats to analyze and proposed graphical presentations of the results</li> <li>Methods can be replicated by others</li> <li>Methods support objectives</li> <li>Manageable and able to be completed in the duration of this course (for project 2)</li> </ul>
<b>Present Results</b> (projected only. Your results in project 2 may be different than those presented here)	Your results meet ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You did not provide results for any methods</li> </ul>	Your results meet ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The results are not presented in the same order as indicated in your methods</li> <li>You are missing results you indicated in the methods section</li> </ul>	Your results meet ALL of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All results presented in same order as methods</li> <li>The results are displayed as indicated in your methods</li> <li>The results follow a logical order</li> </ul>
<b>Conclusion</b> This section consists of a analysis of your proposed results	Your conclusion meet ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You only restate the results, there is no interpretation or relationship given</li> </ul>	Your conclusion meet ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Incorrect interpretation of the results</li> </ul>	Your conclusion meet ALL of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>specifically related to the results indicated in the results section</li> <li>provides an interpretation of the results</li> <li>includes suggestions for policy application and future analysis</li> </ul>
<b>Format of Project 1</b>	Project 1 format meet ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Disregard for the 2 pt criteria</li> <li>Significant number of grammatical and/or spelling errors</li> </ul>	Project 1 format meets ANY of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You are missing any of the criteria listed in the 2 pts</li> <li>grammatical and/or spelling errors found, but not significant amount</li> </ul>	Project 1 is formatted to meet ALL of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>no more than 6 pages</li> <li>each section is on a separate page</li> <li>at least 3 sentences per paragraph</li> <li>double spaced</li> <li>name, title and page numbers on all pages</li> <li>written concisely and to the point</li> </ul>
