PROMPT interdisciplinary team is confirmed, all are prepared to participate</li> <li>2.Meeting times have been scheduled based on agreed upon time. Virtual option</li> <li>3.Kickoff held (insert date) with majority of clinicians in attendance</li> </ol>
<b>Three Things to Accomplish in Next 60 Days</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Evaluate policies regarding severe HTN</li> <li>2.Ensure rapid access to severe HTN medications</li> <li>3.Provide education to all team members- Free CME from AIM</li> </ol>
<b>Three Things to Accomplish in Next 90 Days</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. SOPs are all updated</li> <li>2.1<sup>st</sup> Severe HTN drill will be held for both day &amp; night shifts</li> <li>3.On Agenda for OB Division to share PROMPT &amp; baseline findings, any process issues</li> </ol>
