- 5. Enter number of HIV/HCV co-infected patients (antibody-positive) in each ethnicity/race category. (May estimate based on random sample of at least thirty patient records)
- 6. Enter number of HIV/HCV co-infected patients (antibody-positive) who are of Hispanic, Latino/a or Spanish origin. (May estimate based on random sample of at least thirty patient records)
- 7. Enter number of HIV/HCV co-infected patients with positive Viral Loads in clinic.
- 8. Enter number of HIV/HCV co-infected patients with positive Viral Loads who are deemed permanently ineligible for treatment according to treatment guidelines or clinic protocols.
