## **PROJECT ANNOUNCEMENTS**

- Thank you for participating in this project and helping it to be successful. We are busy analyzing data and will share the compiled report with sites in the Spring.
- Mandatory data entry is completed. For those sites who joined later or who are interested in continuing to submit data, the database will be open until 4/15/15. Sites are welcome to submit sustainability data using the abbreviated data collection sheet into a new database. Sustainability data will be collected through 12/31/15 and data reports will be generated quarterly.
