Abu Hassan Ahmad has been at the School of Biological Sciences, Universiti Sains Malaysia since 1980 and as Professor of Entomology in 2000. He has taught courses in entomology and ecology for the undergraduates. Besides teaching, he has supervised 25 MSc and 15 PhD in entomology. His research has been focused on mosquito ecology and control. The emerging of dengue recently has turned his attention to conduct research on *Aedes* mosquitoes (*Aedes aegypti* and *Aedes albopictus*).

Professor Abu Hassan graduate students came from Middle East, Africa and South East Asian countries, in addition to students from Malaysia. He has been involved in mosquito control in Saudi Arabia and Khartoum, Sudan. He has been the Deputy Dean for seven years and as the Dean for five years between 2000 and 2012.
