GME POLICY & PROCEDURE**

Title: Educational Resources Devoted to Pain Medicine Policy	GME-400
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Scope: Applies to the University of South Florida Morsani College of Medicine (“USF MCOM”) Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (“ACGME”) Pain Medicine Fellowship Program.

Background: The ACGME mandates that sponsoring institutions must have an institutional policy governing the educational resources committed to the Pain Medicine program that ensures cooperation of all the involved disciplines [Pain Medicine program requirement I.B.1.b)]. There must be a multidisciplinary fellowship committee to regularly review the program's resources and its attainment of stated goals and objectives

Policy: USF MCOM sponsors a single Pain Medicine fellowship program under the Department of Neurology. The program will establish and maintain a multidisciplinary fellowship committee to regularly review program’s resources and attainment of its stated goals and objectives. This committee could be accomplished through the program evaluation committee if the program evaluation committee has multidisciplinary representatives.

The Designated Institutional Official (“DIO”), Core Program Director, Fellowship Program Director, and the Graduate Medical Education Committee (“GMEC”) monitor educational resources committed to the Pain Medicine fellowship through the Annual Program Evaluation Review and the Annual ACGME Survey of Residents’ Educational and Clinical Experiences to ensure that program and institution are meeting the ACGME requirements as described above.
