

## Morsani College of Medicine Summer Research Program

**Overview:** The Morsani College of Medicine Summer Research Program supports undergraduate students in obtaining positions in a research laboratory. The program is designed for students with a strong background in science and who may be considering careers in research, medicine, and teaching. Students will be exposed to research opportunities in a laboratory setting which will assist the student in developing new skills, gaining professional experience, and translating classroom knowledge into relevant biomedical research.

**Eligibility:** The program is primarily designed for undergraduate or post baccalaureate students. Other types of students may be considered.

**Expectation:** Students must be willing to participate in a research lab for 10 weeks during the summer. A current or previous affiliation with USF is not required.

## **Application Materials:**

- 1. One-page personal statement (please include areas of research interest and if you have already identified a faculty mentor, please indicate it in the statement)
- 2. Resume/CV
- 3. Copy of current transcript

**Review Process:** Applications will be reviewed as soon as they are received and shared with potential faculty mentors. Prospective candidates will be contacted by individual investigators who will conduct their own interviews.
